Community

Sport, at all levels, is a vital part of a community. Tadworth Primary Football Club (The Club) will take into account community feeling when making decisions.

Equality

Participants

The Club recognises the sense of ownership felt by those who participate at all levels of sport. Environment

The club is committed to respecting the environments used by ourselves and other clubs. This means grounds, clubhouses and playgrounds and neighbourhoods of the venue we play at.

Home Ground Rules

The club is committed to respecting our home ground at Tadworth Primary School. This means:

1. No Smoking within the school premises.
2. No pets – particularly dogs – within the school premises.
3. Trainers should be worn to and from the pitches to avoid spreading mud and grass from the pitches onto the school playgrounds.
4. Parking must be considerate and only in designated parking spaces.
5. Litter must be tidied away and removed.
6. The neighbourhood and neighbours around the school must be respected.
